

The purpose of the Steel City Softball League (SCSL) Hall of Fame is to recognize the contributions made by a member of the SCSL or that of a SCSL sponsor, to the SCSL itself or to the LGBTQ+ community while a member or sponsor of the SCSL.

## Criteria/Nominating

1. Any long-standing member of the SCSL, living or deceased, (including players, managers, coaches, scorekeepers, social (nonplayers) and fans), who have been in an association for at least ten years are eligible for nomination to the Hall of Fame.
2. Nominees should have made significant contributions to the league and/or to the LGBTQ+ community while part of the SCSL.
3. When nominations are open and have been announced a nominee or someone on behalf of the nominee must complete the SCSL Hall of Fame application. This application must be submitted to the Executive Board prior to the voting.
4. The applications may be submitted by any person, including the candidates themselves. The application should include a photograph of the nominee.
  - a. No more than four members can be inducted in any year.
  - b. Nominated people who are not elected can be nominated again in future seasons (years).
  - c. All members of the SCSL Hall of Fame shall be non-billable lifetime individual non-playing members of the league (Social Membership).

## Voting

1. Voting members will consist of all eligible members of the Board of Directors.
2. Voting on the nominees will occur at a designated Board of Directors meeting each year. Voting will be based on the credentials presented with the applications.
3. The candidates who receive at least two-thirds of the votes cast are inducted into the SCSL Hall of Fame.
4. No absentee ballots will be allowed.
